What’s New in a New Horizon?

Recently, we have designed a custom chassis that allows for more head height in the upper deck (normally the bedroom and bathroom). Our design has increased the overall height of the unit to 13’ 6”, but offers interior heights of 6’11” to 7’2” in the upper deck area. The only drawback to this design is that it can only be towed by a truck equipped with a hauler body. Conventional truck beds do not have enough clearance for this design change to work. (please note: this is not our standard)



The picture on the left shows the interior height is almost 7’.

The picture on the right is Cole Brokenicky demonstrating that a New Horizons can offer increased interior height in the bathroom/bedroom.

Another recent change is the complete re-design of the equipment offered in our Summit Series. For 2015, standard equipment now includes a 3 color exterior paint scheme, solid surface countertops, and the same infrastructure with chassis and insulation as our Majestic Model. Available in either our 96” wide unit, or our 102” chassis, the Summit offers the same New Horizons Majestic quality with fewer bells and whistles. Priced at roughly \$20,000 less than a Majestic, the Summit model may be a great item to look at if the Majestic is just out of your budget!

Chicago Dip



Prep Time: 15 Minutes

Ready in: 20 Minutes

Servings: 10

Ingredients:

- 1 (10 ounce) package frozen chopped spinach, thawed & drained
- 1 cup sour cream
- 1 cup mayonnaise
- $\frac{3}{4}$ cup chopped green onions
- 2 teaspoons dried parsley
- 1 teaspoon lemon juice
- $\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoon seasoned salt
- 1 (1 pound) loaf round, crusty Italian bread

Directions:

1. In a large mixing bowl, combine spinach, sour cream, mayonnaise, green onions, parsley, lemon juice and salt. Mix until well blended, then refrigerate.
2. Cut a circle out of the top of the bread and scoop out the inside. Tear the inside into pieces for dipping. Spoon the dip into the center of the bread bowl and serve accompanied by the pieces of bread for dipping.
3. Serve

Footnotes

Cook's Notes:

If your bread loaf is large, you may need to double the dip recipe.

To heat the dip: wrap the dip-filled loaf in aluminum foil. Place in a 300 degrees F (150 degrees C) oven for 1 to 2 hours. Remove from oven and turn foil back. Use reserved bread, cut into pieces, for dipping.
